1- Egyptian Patent Office (EGPO)

Historical background

The Egyptian patent office was established in 1951 for patents issuing and protecting inventors' rights, in application of patent and industrial designs law 132 of 1949, modified to IPR law 82 of 2002.

The Egyptian patent office is one of the most prominent states bodies. It is crucible of creativities and innovations directed to the world of technology and industry and global market, thus pushing the wheel of economic and industrial development in Egypt.

Due to its high importance, Egypt directs its effort towards innovation support and linking scientific research with industry for industrial application of research outcomes and technical information. Such efforts are exerted for the sake of public benefit and coping with technology revolution.

Accordingly, the Egyptian patent office has undergone different developmental phases since its establishment in 1951 until it reaches the highest level of coping with modern technology under the effect of international treaties and agreements. As a result, the Egyptian patent office has acquired the first rank among Arab patent offices and becomes on an equal footing with European patent offices.

Objectives

The Egyptian patent office has been established with the aim of protecting the intellectual property of patents and utility models in Egypt as well as encouraging invention and innovation, hence contributing to the economic growth.

Tasks

- Proceeding with actions required for patent and utility models protection
- Filing and examining patent applications and utility models
- Granting inventions and utility models patents for both Egyptians and non-Egyptians
- Contributing to develop the citizens' innovation skills
- Supporting industries
- Encouraging specialists in the production and scientific research sector to register their inventions

Introduction

Patent information adds to the value of protection applications; it reveals the latest technical information in different fields of science. Therefore, the Egyptian patent office seeks to build a public database of all published documents in accordance with the system and executive legislation of patents and utility models.

Introduction



Introducing information technology tools and supporting their use in office work administration is one of the office dynamics to confront IP challenges of





a cornerstone for boosting small and medium-sized industries for the economic benefit of both society and individuals.









1- International cooperation, international treaties and relations:

International cooperation with China

- On June 20, 2017, the rapid path agreement for applications examination was concluded between both the Egyptian and Chinese patent offices. According to the agreement, the PPH program would be adopted for two year trial in order to facilitate the examination procedures of applications submitted to both offices, decisions follow-up and exchange between technical examiners.
- In its capacity as an international searching and examination authority, technical examiners of EGPO are responsible for applications searching and examination.
- In its capacity as an international searching and examination authority, EGPO technical examination department should apply quality measures to filed PCT applications, according to Handbook of Procedures, chapter 21.

International cooperation with the European Commission

On February 2017 and March 2017, a meeting was held for agreement renewal with experts from the European Commission with the aim of drafting a twinning project between the Egyptian patent office and a EU patent office.
